# ROUTINE DENTIST, OPTICIANS AND DOCTORS APPOINTMENTS

Please make routine doctors, dentist and optician appointments for after the school day or during school holidays. Unfortunately, unless we are given evidence of an appointment (i.e. an appointment card or letter) then the absence will be recorded as 'unauthorised'.

#### **CHILDREN ARRIVING AT SCHOOL EARLY**

Children should not arrive at school before 8.45am unless they are booked into Breakfast Club.

We have had children arriving at school as early as 8.10am. There should not be any children arriving before 8.45am when they can be supervised.
