NO DOGS ON THE SCHOOL GROUNDS

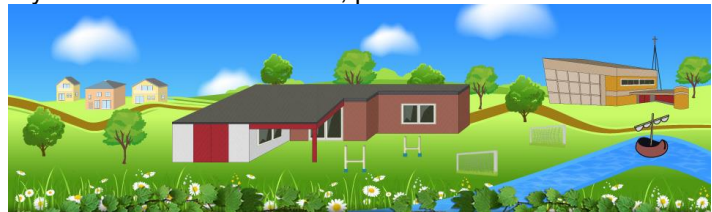
Please be reminded that, regardless of the size of your dog, **no dogs are permitted on school grounds.**
