## Summary of current situation in PE

- Currently, the school hold the Gold School Games Mark award.
- PE is taught by the class teacher using the Real PE scheme of work.
- School staff will be increasing the offer of After School Sports Clubs this academic year.

## Subject timeline (include CPD, resources purchased and subject events)

- Monitoring to take place x1 per half term as part of the schools 'new' monitoring system.
- Resources Audit to be completed in Autumn 2025 to ensure all equipment is still of high-quality and to ensure staff have everything they need to be able to deliver high-quality PE lessons
  - School to take part in Wigan Active Schools sports events as appropriate.
- Sports Day will be booked for June 2026 – exact day TBC.
- Whole School National Sports week to be planned and activities to take place w.c. 06.07.26
- RC to attend the Wigan PE lead meetings.
