<p>Can use a digital camera and IT programs to create images and art work that includes their own work and that of others.</p> <p>Join two parts successfully using e.g. wire, paper</p> <p>Construct a simple base for extending and modelling other shapes.</p> <p>Can create 3d image from wire.</p> <p>Can compare the work of different artists and describe what they think or feel about own and others' work.</p> <p>Can explore ideas and change what they have done to give a better result.</p> <p>Can adapt and improve work thinking about the purpose of it.</p>	
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
