Spelling	Definition
senses	There are five senses - sight, smell, hearing, taste, and touch
reptiles	Reptiles include snakes, lizards, crocodiles, turtles, and tortoises. They have a dry scaly skin and usually lay soft-shelled eggs on land.
amphibians	Amphibians include frogs, toads and newts. They live in water but can spend time on land.
mammal	An animal that has hair or fur and feeds their young with milk.
fish	An animal with gills and fins living in water.
birds	An animal with feathers, wings, a beak and can fly.
vertebrate	backbone
herbivore	Meat eater
carnivore	Plant eater
omnivore	Meat and plant eater
