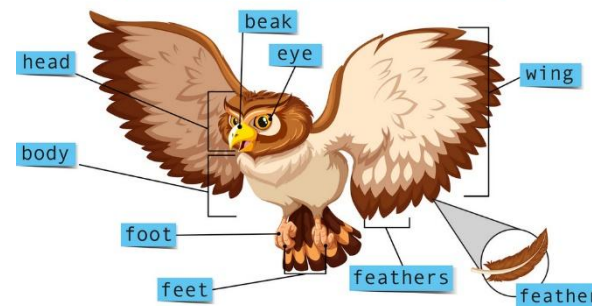


What? (Key Vocabulary)
