Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s),

This term we will be studying the two branches *To The Ends of the Earth* and *Dialogue and Encounter*. Each class will approach the themes differently.

TO THE ENDS OF THE EARTH

(13th April – 21st May)

Preschool – Jesus sends the Holy Spirit to love us. The Holy Spirit helps us to love one another.

Year 1 - When people open their hearts to the Holy Spirit, they are changed.

SUGGESTIONS FOR HOME ACTIVITIES

Consider how we can find strength from the Holy Spirit to follow in God's footsteps.

Talk to your child about the importance of making tough choices and how we can talk to God, Jesus or the Holy Spirit to ask for help in times of need.

May is the month of Our Lady – collect flowers and make a May altar at home around a statue/painting of Our Lady.

(1st June – 17th July)

SUGGESTIONS FOR HOME ACTIVITIES

Talk together about times when you have forgiven and been forgiven. Discuss the importance of saying sorry. Look for opportunities for forgiveness and reconciliation in the day-to-day life of the family.

ISLAM (15th June – 26th June)

Pupils will study various aspects of Islam for two weeks. Ask them what they have been learning about.

(29th June – 17th July)
